Colonists and soldiers in the Colonies. Militias, at present  
employed in the service by Government in cutting a road  
to their place of settlement: have 2 acres of land each  
and with their wives in a temporary settlement in the neigh-  
bourhood of their employment: are distinguishable from  
the Colonists by being more loyal, orderly and respectful. re-  
ceive the lowest wages in the Colony (9d per day & Rice for  
other Expences.
