on board captured by that Ship's
Boats in Lat 5. 49 North, and
Long 9. 7 West. — And on
the 28th H. M. S. Myrmidon
sent in another Spanish Schooner
called N. S. de las Nieves with
One hundred and twenty two
Slaves on board captured by
the Myrmidon's Boats in Lat 7.
North and Long 12 West. —

The Esperanza was
condemned as legal Prize on the
27th Instant, and I have the honor
to enclose for Your Lordship's
Information the case of that vessel.

The Court would have
proceeded this day to the adjudication
of the N. S. de las Nieves, had it
not been prevented by the indisposition
of

of Mr. Hamilton, the Registrar,
who has been unwell for some
days: the Slaves however were
all landed as some of them
were rather sickly.
