Thursday the 25th day of June 1831.

The Commissioners having had under
consideration Surgeon Baskin's charge for Medical
Inspection and attendance on the Males of the Spanish
Scholar *Donna Maria* amounting to Thirty five
Pounds Sterling directed that the same may be paid
from the proceeds of sale of the said vessel.

On the same day

An application from Mr. Charles Bennett was
read, requesting that he may be appointed in the
Department of Marshal of the British and Spanish
Court of War Commission - which the Commission
signified they would take into consideration.
