My Lord,

The big leave, with reference to the Dispatch, marked N. 4, which we had the honor of addressing to Your Lordship on the 7th Instant, to inform Your Lordship that a Portuguese Brig named the *Garcia*, captured by Commodore Sir George Collier, brought her on the 17th Instant, forty seven slaves belonging to the number found on board of the Spanish Schooner, *Anna Maria* at the time of capture. These forty seven slaves, with seven who died on board of the *Garcia*, were originally removed from the *Anna Maria*, owing to her crowded state, into H. M. Ship *Tartar* from whence they were put on board of the *Garcia*.

The total number of slaves emancipated and registered from the *Anna Maria* is four hundred; and the total number of the slave belonging to that vessel who died
