the Petition of Gonzales de Braganza Master of
the condemned Portuguese Schooner Adelaide, praying
that a sum of Twenty Pounds out of the Proceeds of
certain Goods the private property of the said Master
may be granted to him by the Board to provide for his
Subsistence, Captain Kelly the Captain having given
his consent thereto, - The Board was pleased to direct
that the sum of Twenty Pounds should be accordingly
paid to the said Petitioner from the Proceeds of the
said Goods. -
