

Spanish Schooner 'Ycanani' Register of Slaves, native of Africa, captured on board the said ship by His Britannic Majesty's Ships of War, 'Phaenix' & 'Thetis' Com. Mod. Sir Robert Meade, Bart. & man. det. and emancipated by decree of the British and Spanish Court of Vice-Com. in Spain on the 10 day of June 1812, the said schooner having been pronounced liable to condemnation by the said Court on the same day, for having been at the time of Capture engaged in the illicit traffic in Slaves.
