The Commissioners of Apprenticeship
 and Sale of the Portuguese Brigantine
 Constantia
 For Charges, Labour, Canoe hire &c during Coast
 Vessel and in the landing Warehousing &c of her Cargo and
 in landing and attending upon Slaves belonging to.

To proceeding with a Medical officer at different
 times Onboard the "Constantia", "Garcia's" "Hull"
 "Lartat" and "Hull D Thistle" mustering the Slaves
 Onboard each Vessel belonging to the Constantia
 taking an account of their Number & Condition
 & reporting same respectively

To Acting Witnesses four in number landing
 them and attending them to the Office

To landing on different days from Onboard the
 several Vessels above mentioned the sick Slaves
 & subsequently the remainder, attending them
 respectively while in the Gaol Yard and
 to the Office for Registry

To procuring Interpreters and paying same
 sundry times

To pay for 6 Pieces of Cloth used at sundry
 times for clothing the Slaves.

To Return of Slaves

To reporting Prisoners attending them to the
 Commissariat Office and obtaining Rations
 and Quarters.
