

Portuguese Schooner 'Nymphe del Mar' - Register of Slaves natives of Africa captured on board the said vessel by His Britannic Majesty's Ship of War 'Iphigenia' in Robert Meade's Boat-Commander and emancipated by Decree of the British and Portuguese Court of Mixed Commission on the 29th day of August 1832 the said Schooner ^{having} been pronounced liable to condemnation by the said Commission on the same day, for having been at the time of capture engaged in the illicit traffic in Slaves.
