

Portuguese Schooner "Magdalena da Pracca" Register of Slaves natives of Africa captured on board the said vessel by His Britannic Majesty's Ship of War "Pamir" Charles Phillips Esquire Commander and emancipated by Senec of the British and Portuguese Court of Slave Commission on the 23rd day of January 1813 the said Schooner having been pronounced liable to condemnation by the said Commission on the same day for having been at the time of capture engaged in the illicit traffic in Slaves.
