 and emancipated by decree of the British and Spanish Court of Mixed Commission on the third
 day of January 1826, the said Schooner having been pronounced liable to condemnation by
 the said Commission on the same day for having been at the time of Capture engaged in the illicit
 traffic in Slaves.
