Commander and Ammirante. by decree of the British and Portuguese Court of Mixed Commission on the 8th day of June 1826. The said Sloop having been pronounced liable to Condemnation by the said Commission on the same day for having been at the time of Capture Engaged in the illicit traffic in Slaves.
