

### Portuguese Galeota 'Anuelias'

Register of Slaves Natives of Africa; captured on board the said vessel by His Majesty's Ship 'Prima' Thomas Larille Duffin Esquire Commander, and emancipated by Decree of the British and Portuguese Court of Mixed Commission on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1829. The said Galeota having on the day aforesaid been pronounced liable forfeiture and accordingly condemned by the said Commission for having been at the time of capture and seizure thereof engaged in the direct traffic in Slaves. —
