

Spanish Brig "Rapido."

Register of Slave Natives of Africa captured on board the said vessel, by His Britannic Majesty's Brigantine "Fair Rosamond", a tender to His Britannic Majesty's Ship "Dryad", Commadore John Hayes, C.B. Commander, and emancipated by decree of the British and Spanish Court of Mixed Commissions established in this Colony of Sierra Leone, on the seventh day of November, 1831. The said Brig having on the day aforesaid been pronounced liable to confiscation; and accordingly condemned by the said Commission for having been at the time of capture and seizure thereof engaged in the illicit traffic in Slaves.
